

THE TROOP 30 "GOLDEN SPATULA" AWARD

To "stir up the pot" and encourage higher quality Patrol cooking, the Troop is now going to recognize and reward Patrols that exhibit excellence in cooking.



Rules:

- During designated Troop Outings, the Patrols will all participate in a cooking competition, with the winning Patrol being awarded the "Golden Spatula."
- Patrols will be responsible for creating and executing creative and well balanced meals that taste great!
- Impartial Judges (special guests or non-Patrol senior Scout and adult leaders) will be assigned to evaluate each Patrol's cooking effort, and (using predetermined criteria) will decide who the winner will be for that particular Troop Outing.
- The winning Patrol will be given the Golden Spatula, plus a special prize determined by the Troop Scoutmaster.
- The Golden Spatula will be up for grabs again at the next designated Troop Outing; until that Troop Outing, the winning Patrol has full "bragging rights" over the other Patrols.
- Changes to the above rules and judging criteria may be made at any time, but advance notice will be given.
